Community Description

Beacon Falls has a population of 6,033 and covers 10 square miles. Demographically, 92% of residents are white, 6% Hispanic or Latino, and 1% Black or African American. Twenty-five percent (25%) of Beacon Falls households (617 of 2466 households) meet the ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) threshold, meaning that the household earns more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the area. Goal 1: One Library Card, Countless Possibilities

Library cards are free! Beacon Falls residents are eligible for a card, yet only 18% of Beacon Falls residents have one.

- Increase the number of residents with a library card.
- Spread the word that library cards can be used in any Connecticut library to gain access to multiple formats of material.
- Collaborate with local schools, public departments, and local businesses to promote library cards.

Goal 2: Expanding the Door to Knowledge

Expand the current library building or build a new library to replace the current 1250-square-foot library.

- Appoint a building committee.
- Outline a proposed plan.
- Survey the community.
- Work with a consultant/architect/engineer.
- Modernize library facilities to be ADA-compliant and responsive to community needs.
- Develop a plan for financing.

Goal 3: Spread the Word

Enhance the visibility of the library in the community and market programs and services.

- Use the town and library websites.
- Create bi-monthly print newsletters.
- Create and post flyers.
- Use social media such as Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, and TikTok.
- Reach out to/engage schools and senior center.

Goal 4: Discover, Connect, Inspire

The library will provide a location for lifelong learning in person or virtually and provide a space for individuals to meet and connect.

- Implement relevant and diverse programming for all ages.
- Keep current and accurate print and downloadable resources to meet the needs of the community.
- Expand training to increase a patron's ability to use computers and electronic devices.
